They started asking, “Who is out there? Who has made this noise? Maybe a thief has come?” One lady who always went on finding fault with this humble, dear sevadar of the Master was heard to say, “Who else can it be than that homeless Amru whom nobody is taking care of”

The next morning when Guru Angad Dev Ji was told what had happened and what this person had said about His beloved disciple, He replied, “Yes, that is true, Bhai Amar Das, is that homeless one who will give the true eternal home to millions of souls.”

Our Great Satguru, Sant Ajaib Singh Ji Maharaj earned a vast treasury of the priceless, immaculate wealth of Naam (the liberator, the giver of eternal life). He did the extreme and incomparable austerity and sacrifice, and pleasing God Almighty and His Perfect Guru Kirpal; He became the infinite storehouse of Naam.

He has kept one humble Sadhu, who is your full time and unpaid servant and sevadar, As the treasurer of His earnings (wealth) of Naam.
